

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found 1" x 12" iron pipe in monument box over large stone. Stone at least 36" x 30" in diameter with drill hole. Stone 1999: down 1.25'. Surface marker 0.06' South and 0.01' West of drill hole.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Southeast corner, Section 10, T. 4 S., R. 9 W., ratified by the Kalamazoo County Remonumentation Program Peer Group on I-05: September 9, 1999 and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner. Found 1" x 12" pipe In monument box over large stone with drill hole. Stone is believed to be drilled stone found in 1911 by E. Strong, County Surveyor. Placed 10" of 20" Harrison monument over drill hole with monument box over.
