

Snell</u>, in a field survey on <u>Nov. 11</u>, 19.99 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed before: do hereby state that under

## A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1826: United States Government Surveyors, R. Clark; West between Sections 7 and 18, 40 chains. Set 1/4 Section post in prairie and raised mound: 77.90 chains entered West boundary at post (mound in prairie).

F. Hodgman, County Surveyor; "Original 1/4 post lost. Divided Section line proportionately and planted stake and stone, from which Maple 3" N. 87° W. 46 lks., Cherry 6" S. 89° E. 64 lks. Another stake about 10 lks. West not properly established by (M. M.) Stimson 1870: is incorrect."

F. Hodgman, County Surveyor; "Found stone with stake under and bearing trees of resurvey standing." 1889:

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Wilkins & Wheaton Engr. Co.; placed iron in pavement from witness. In fence lines East and West, Maple 26" N. 87° W. 29.0', 12" Elm S. 87° E. 26.5', 24" Maple N. 45° W. 43.9'. 1939:

1960:

Michigan State Highway Department, N.G. McManus, RLS #6935; found 3/4" iron rod. 25" Oak N. 05° E. 33.17' 27° Oak S. 65° W. 55.73' 13" Sassafras 13" Sassafras N. 60° W. 71.94'

Michigan State Highway Department, Projects 39-6, 39-7 Route U.S. 131 (Map 3); 1/4 corner is 0.90' E. of center line of South 1964: bound lanes.

1969: Wilkins & Wheaton Engr. Co.; field notes call for lead plug - not in line

1999: Witnesses gone - new pavement over concrete highway. Re-established by running South line of Section and divided proportionately. Placed "mag nail" at corner and 1/2" x 18" irons at intersection of right-of-way's, 130' East and 70' West. Government measure 77.90 chains measure 5,201.95' - B-05 - S. 1/4 to E. 1/4 C-05 = 2,671.09. Directed by Peer Group to move corner 1.72' South to match lead plug as noted in 1964 and 1969 above.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

B-05: South 1/4 post, Section 7, T. 4 S., R. 11 W., ratified by the Kalamazoo County Remonumentation Program Peer Group on December 9, 1999, and is accepted as a careful and faithful re-establishment of the position of the original corner. Established South line by proportionately bisecting to Government measure (see "A" above). Government 1/2 mile = 40.0 chains (2,640.00'), Mile = 77.90 chains (5,141.00'). Placed South 1/4 post at 2,671.09 feet from Southeast corner and measured mile at 5,201.95'. Set "mag" nail in center line of South bound lanes of U.S. Route 131 in South line of Section 7, then moved Southerly 1.72' as directed by Peer Group and set "mag" nail. Placed 30" Harrison monuments on relocated Section line at intersection of both right-of-way lines, 130.00' East and 70.00 West.

Straight line between Southwest corner and Southeast corner assumed = East and West.
