B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring of reestablishing corner:

I found a 1/2" Capped Iron (LS 14102) by J. Wilcox in a monument box in the centerline of a North and South road. Wilcox surveyed for new road construction in 1995 more or less. The recovered accessories fit this found corner.

Condition of the accessories are as follows: #1 Gone, #2 Gone, #3 Gone, #4 Found in poor condition #5 Found in good condition, #6 Found in good condition.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

I accepted the 1/2" capped iron in the monument box as a substantial monument for the corner, and is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
