I found 1" Iron Pipe and Cedar Stake near fence corner and accepted as the true position of the corner. Condition of the witnesses are: #1 gone, #2 Gone, #3 Gone, #4 Gone, #5 Found in good condition, #6 Found in good condition, #7 Tree blown down.
