1838 John Mullett, D.S. G.L.O. #1 14" Cedar N10°E 18 Links #2 12" Cedar N74°W 25 Links

1938 Brue Elliott U.S.F.S. (Jr. Forester) Found old cedar stake & set the following #3 Pine Post N71°W 0.08 Chains

1983 Clinton E. Cole L.S. 17615: found Elliott's Pine Post and set corner (1/2" rod) using elliotts bearing and distance from post, and took the following witnesses: #4 18" Maple N79°E 28.65'; #5 8" Maple N15°E 51.20'; #6 10" Maple N67°W 9.44'. He recorded an Act 74 in Liber 2, Page 442 and on November 16, 1985 re-recorded in Liber 3, Page 33.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

D-13 (1/4 Corner Section 32, T17N, R13W, on County Line)

I found Surveyor Cole's 1/2" rod and accessories. I also found Elliott's Pine Post. I accepted Cole's 1/2" rod. Corner is 306' more or less East of old railroad grade and 21 feet more or less North of Cedar Creek. Condition of accessories are: #1 Gone, #2 Gone, #3 Found lying down in poor condition, #4 Found in good condition, #5 Found in good condition, #6 Found in good condition.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

D-13 (1/4 Corner Section 32, T17N, R13W, on County Line)

Replaced 1/2" Re-rod with 3/4" x 24" Re-rod with Lake County Brass Cap, and is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
