B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring of reestablishing corner:

I found Blass' railroad spike 4' North of centerline of East and West road and in centerline of roads North and South. I also found an old 1-1/2" pipe S56°E 3.0 feet from the railroad spike. I accepted the railroad spike as the correct corner, as it best fit accessory #4 by G. H. Johnson and I did not know the origin of the 1 1/2" Pipe. I removed the pipe.

Condition of the accessories are as follows: #1 Gone, #2 Gone, #3 Gone, #4 Found in good condition, #5 Found in good condition, #6 New Pole, #7 Found in good condition, #8 Found in good condition, #9 Found in good condition, #10, Found in good condition, #11 Found in good condition, #12 Found in good condition.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

I replaced the railroad spike with a 3/4" x 24" re-bar with Lake County Remon Cap, and is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
