B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found 60d spike over rifle barrel, that was set by single proportionate distance by George Blass. Surveyor Blass was aware of Anderson's and West's corner and their measured distances. He did not find their monument or accessories and treated as a lost corner, probablly because of the inconsistancy of their measurements. I accepted Blass's corner.
