B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring of reestablishing corner:

I found Cole's 1/2" rebar 4 feet more or less West of centerline of North and South road. I found what I thought was Hollister's Pine Stump to the Southwest. I excavated (at Hollister's bearing and distance) an area 3' x 6' (6 feet deep) to find stone. I did not recover stone. I accepted Cole's 1/2" rod.

Condition of the accessories are as follows: #1 Gone, #2 Gone, #3 Gone, #4 Gone, #5 Found stump, #6 Gone, #7 Found in poor condition.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

I replaced Cole's 1/2" rod with a 3/4" x 24" rebar with Lake County Remon Cap, and is accepted as a careful and faithful SE RIENIE reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
