- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
 - E-9 Section corner common to Sections 20, 21, 28 & 29, T18N, R11W, Pinora Twp., Lake Co., Ni.

I found the D.N.R. monument 17" below surface of road intersection (East, West North and South). I also found accessory No. 3, which checked well with old records. All the other accessories had been destroyed with road improvements. There had been a severe cut in this area which probably destroyed the stone set by Hollister.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

E-9 - Section corner common to Sections 20, 21, 28 & 29, T18N, R11W, Pinora Twp., Lake Co., Ni.

I accepted the D.N.R. Monument as a substantial monument for the corner and is accepted as a careful and faithful re-establishment of the position of the original corner.
