I found 4" x 36" Concrete Monument and all the above accessories (that fit said monument). I believe surveyor Blass established the position for this corner by using a corner found at the center of Section 28 (which is in a North and South fence line), extending a line from the South 1/4 corner thru the Center 1/4 corner, North to where it intersected a line between the Northwest corner and the Northeast corner of Section 28. I don't believe this position is the same as the G.L.O. because there is no remains of the pine tree. I made an extensive search for this original tree but was not successful. With no contrary evidenced I accepted the Blass corner.
