I found the 2" x 4' Angle Iron by George Johnson (1917) 4 feet below the surface of blacktop road, in an old roadbed. The Angle iron is 6.5 feet East of the Railroad spike used by Clinton E. Cole and 22.4 feet South of corner position by James Fraus. I accepted the 2" Angle Iron as the true location for the corner.
