A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1838 - J. Hodgson, G.L.O. #1 - 18" Sugar S64°W 33 Links #2 - 14" Beech N24°W 42 Links 1920 - F. McClung, Osceola Co. Sur. #3 - Measured 2624.5' South to the East 1/4 corner.

1980 - R.L. Wetherell, LS 24624 Lakestate survey File No. 3523-80 Set 1/2" rebar in intersection of roads. #4 - 10" Cherry S35°E 107.86' #5 - 6" R. Pine N68°E 73.00"

#6 - 3" Maple S38°W 109.83

1891-1904 - Temple/Trubull

The Township of Leroy (T19N R10W) Remonumented the entire township with 3" Clay Tiles with Cinders.

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring of reestablishing corner:

I found the 1/2" rebar I set in 1980. I dug an area 6 feet east and west by 3 feet north and south to a depth of 4 feet more or less, looking for the clay tile, which I did not find. I believe there is probably 7 to 8 feet of road fill at this location. The Osceola County survey records show that F. Trumbull (County Surveyor) set the 1/16 corner South of this corner. I did not recover this 1/16 corner (road cut) but there are old fence lines both East and West that would support the location of the 1/2" rod I set in 1980. I also checked the 1920 McClung distance to the North. I accepted the 1/2" Capped Iron.

Condition of the accessories are as follows: #1 Gone, #2 Gone, #3 Measured 2625' more or less; #4 Found in good condition, #5 Found in good condition, #6 Found in good condition.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

I replaced the 1/2" rod with a 3/4" x 24" re-bar with Lake County Remon cap, and is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
