

- A7 & M7 Standard corner common to Sec. 13 & 24, T19N, R13W and Sec. 18 & 19, T19N, R12W Fd. 'T' iron fence post 28" long at ground level as noted by Blass. Fd. B Oak snag with Blaze at N25°W 58.4' per West. Fd. remains of B. Oak with Blaze per West & Jones at N22°E 69'. Fd. remains of B. Oak stp. at N87°E 47' per Johnson. Fd. Blass BT stps. in agreement w/ 'T' fence post. 'T' iron fence post accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
- A-7 & M-7 Replaced 'T' iron fence post w/ 4" DNR Alum. cap on 1" X 36" Galv. iron pipe.
