B-7 - G.L.O. Set 1/4 post- S. Sibley-1838 Pine 20" N06°E 4.73 chains - G. H. Johnson-1912- survey of N1/2 of NW 1/4 of sec. 19 Iron stake. Pitch Pine 12" N31°W 15 on side of hill.						
B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applies in restoring or re-establishing corner:  B-7- 1/4 corner common to section 18 and 19. Searched extensively of iron stake noted by Johnson but found nothing. Also searched for irons at SW and SE corner of Johnson's survey but found nothing. Did find iron at A7 but it has long history before Johnson's survey. Not sure why we could find no evidence of Johnson's survey. In section 18 find that the N 1/2 of N-S 1/4 line line is monumented by 1" iron pipes at B5 and B6 with a old fence on the line ± This monumented line is 2640'± at right angles and West of the East Line of section 18. The N & S lines of section 18 are nearly 7° off the cardinal direction and quite long from GLO which makes the original survey in this area questionable. Thus making the East 1/2 of section 18 to have 2640' fits GLO for East 1/2 of section 18. Thus set 4" DNR aluminum cap on 1" X 36" galvanized iron pipe by extending line South from monumented B5 and B6 to intersect line between A7 and C7. Top of steep bank to North is 15' North. This maybe side hill Johnson notes. DNR monument accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
