G6 – ¼ Cor. common to sec. 15 & 16 – Fd. ¾" rebar per Wetherell in river bottomland. Found all 4 Wetherell BT's in agreement with rebar but dead. Found N-S barb wire fence mostly in trees is 52' west. Searched for pine stps. called for in old notes but could not find any two that would match a corner location. Former DNR survey Technician Roy Holmquist had also search for evidence of this corner location using pine stp. witnesses in 1973 and he notes not finding them. From ¾" rebar measured North 77' to log jam in Little Manistee River, measured N. 95' +/- to S. riverbank extended from undisturbed bank. GLO calls for 99' to S. riverbank. Accepted ¾" rebar as a careful & faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
