Cobb's position is nearly midway & on line Between his positions at K7 & M7. Cobb's pine stake remains with iron, glass & crockery accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner. Reference Pt. 'B' - Fd. ½ " rebar that fits remains of Salisbury wits – S83°20' W 18.98' from L7. This ½" rebar closely fits Blass & Roser's calculated position which is based on SP position between M7 (Cobb) and Reference Pt.
