

I found the 1/2" re-bar by Fletcher 6 feet East of center of North and South dirt road. I measured the entire mile between Sections 16 & 17 and Found this corner to be halfway and on line between Section corners (within 0.12 feet). The re-bar doesn't fit Nichoson's witness No. 3 by 4 feet more or less, but Nichoson set the corner by single proportionate method. So I accepted the 1/2" iron as found.

Condition of the accessories are as follows: #1 Gone, #2 Gone, #3 Found Stump, #4 Found in good condition, #5 Found in good condition, #6 Found in good condition.
