> I found a 1-1/4" pipe 4 feet long in the centerline of an old road bed running North and 3 feet more or less North of centerline of road East and West. This pipe fits well (with G.L.O. record distance) to a found pipe for the closing Section corner (Sections 1 & 2, T19N, R12W)

None of the above accessories were recovered.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

K-13 - Section corner common to Sections 35 & 36, T2ON, R12W, North Newkirk Twp., Lake Co., Mi.

I replaced the 1-1/4" pipe with a 3/4" x 24" re-bar with a Lake County Brass Cap, and is accepted as a careful and faithful re-establishment of the position of the original corner.
