I found the 5" Square Concrete Monument. I also found a 3/4" Square Iron S6107'06"E 3.54 feet from Griffin's Monument. (Bearing from Griffin's Monument to the Southwest corner of Section 7 is SOOO53'26"W). The 3/4" Square Iron was used in 1952 by Blass to layout some parcels in the Southwest corner of Section 7. In 1959 Blass used the 1-1/4" Pipe. I accepted Griffins 5" Square Monument and removed the 3/4" Square Iron.
