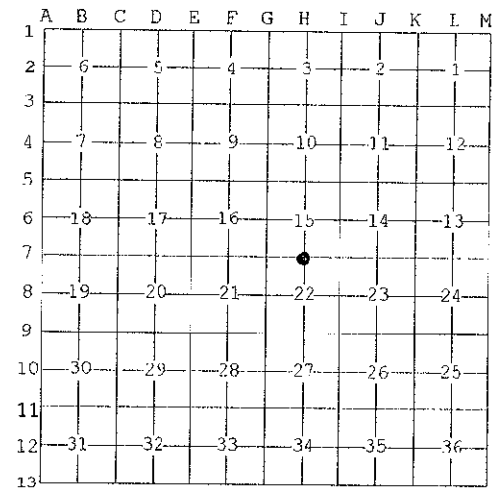

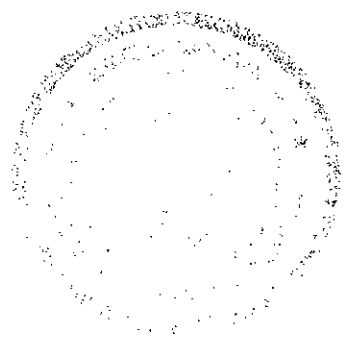

1" iron pipe (well point) accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner by the Leelanau County Remonumentation Peer Review Group on December 16, 1998 and replaced with a 3/4" i.d. x 3.0' long galvanized iron pipe with a stamped brass cap.
