Szyszkoski in a field survey on do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law: established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below

## A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(E9) Section corner common to Sections 20-21-28-29. Corner reestablished and recorded by Billy D. Buckler in 1970. Record shows a 1° pipe with 4" aluminum cap buried in old abandoned N-S road. Bearings: 7" hard maple (\$28 NBT) \$77E 10.6", 5" hard maple (\$21 NBT) NISE

- (4) NW 1/16 corner. Section 29. Corner not set in original survey. Found no subsequent record.
- (8) West 1/16 corner, Section 29. Corner not set in original survey. Found no subsequent record.

## B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(E9) Found and accepted Buckler's monument and accessories as recorded. NBT's have blazes grown over. Placed measuring mails with MDMR tags in these MBT's and scribed new BH blaze as described below. Also marked two additional bearing trees. Corner is in center of old abandoned road at an E-W chain gate.

(4) Established corner at the computed intersection straight lines connecting opposite 1/16 corners, the NI/16 and the WI/16 being monumented. The West 1/16 between 20-29 and the Worth 1/16 between 29-30 were computed only, and not monumented in this survey. Found no acqueentation or evidence of use at the corner location.

(8) Found no monumentation or evidence of use at corner location. Established corner midway and on a straight lipe between the monumented W1/4 corner and the Center of Section 29 (the center being unmonumented by this survey - computed as the intersection of straight lines connecting opposite 1/4 corners). At the position for the corner, I placed a standard MDNR monument described below. Measured distance north to NW1/16 corner as 1320.41; west to the 1/4 corner is 1311.14%.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
(E9) Found 1" pipe with 4" aluminum cap (4) Set a 1"x32" painted from pipe capped (8) Set a 1"x32" painted from pipe capped stamped to identify the corner. Placed double headed mails with MDNA tags in the lidentify the corner. Set double headed following trees: \$53E 10.8' in M face 13" maple (\$28) (Buckler's NBT), 569W 35.6' in N face of power pole, NION 25.15' in E face 10° maple (\$20 MBT), N21E 35.04° in W face B' maple (S21) (Buckler's NBT).

with a 4° cast aluminum tablet stamped to mails with MDMR tags in the following trees: MI4W 12.10' in SW face B' maple (1/16 BT), N75E 28.6' in S face 7" maple (1/16 BT), \$34E 12.87' in W face 7" poplar (1/16 BT), \$80W 9.15' in # face 5" maple (1/16 BT). Placed 4° squared balsam post adjacent to west.

with a 4" cast aluminum tablet stamped to identify the corner. Placed double headed nails with MDNA tags in the following trees: \$75W 4.4' in N face 8" balsag (1/16 BT), N41W 4.3' in NE face 6" Yellow Birch (1/16 BT), \$32E 16.72' in NE face 9" maple 11/16 BT), \$20W 7.79' in NW face 11" maple (1/16 BT). Placed 4" squared maple post south, 1%.
