

5. Private Claims

12" Fir N 60° W 20 lks Billy Buckler, P.S. 8887, found a 2" well point and 2 wood posts "set by an unknown surveyor" for the corner P.S. 1967 Buckler remonumented the corner with a 1" pipe with a 4" aluminum cap and recorded the corner in page 72

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(M-9) Section Corner Common to Sections 24 & 25, T. 45 N., R. 11 W. and Sections 19 & 30, T. 45 N., R. This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Luce County Remonumentation Program.

Could find no evidence of the original corner. Recovered the corner as monumented by Buckler in 1967. Buckler reestablished the position based on evidence recovered in the field and used the position for a survey of the 2 miles South to the township corner. The position currently monumented falls 69.3' West of a line between the section corner 1 mile North and the township corner 2 miles South. After a thorough review of available evidence accepted the corner position as found.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(M-9) Section Corner Common to Sections 24 & 25, T. 45 N., R. 11 W. and Sections 19 & 30, T. 45 N., R. 10 W.

Corner is a 1" pipe with a 4" aluminum Dept. of Conservation cap 18" above ground. The corner falls at the Southerly toe of a ridge running Northwest - Southeast.
