

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

B-5 1/2 Corner Common to Sections 7 & 18, T45N, R10W

1849 - Original corner established by William Ives. Witnesses: Cedar 14, N10°W 12 links - Cedar 12, S10°E 15 links.

Found no evidence of subsequent restoration of this corner.





B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

This comer is being reestablished as part of the Luce County Remonumentation Program. Found no evidence of the original corner. Reestablished corner by single proportionate measurement on line between the section corner on the range line at A-5 to the west and the section corner at C-5 to the east. The distance between said section corners is within 1 foot of the original GLO distance.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Placed a ½" x 18" rebar with a stamped aluminum Luce County Remonumentation cap at the corner location. Witnesses:
