

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

E-6 1/2 Corner Common to Sections 16 & 17, T45N, R10W

1849 - Original corner established by William Ives. Witnesses: Cedar 9, S55°W 04 links - Cedar 10, N54°E 09 links.

Found no evidence of subsequent restoration of this corner.





B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

ONIET CHARLE This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Luce County Remonumentation Program. Found a wood post, broken off and laying down. The found wood post is 2636.8 feet north of the section corner at E-7 (GLO distance is 2640 feet) and is 1051.2 feet south of a similar found post at the meander corner on the south shore of Kak's Lake (GLO distance is 1059.3 feet). I believe that the post may have been set by Harold C. Lawrence, R.L.S. #3218, as a perpetuation of the original corner location. Accepted corner as found and set a rebar and a stamped aluminum Luce County Remonumentation cap in the stub of the broken off post.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Placed a ½" x 18" rebar with a stamped aluminum Luce County Remonumentation cap at the corner location, at the base of a found broken off wood post. Witnesses:
