A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

## I-2 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 2 & 3, T45N, R10W

1849 - Original corner established by William Ives. Witnesses: Cedar 9, S86°W 17 links - Spruce 6, S68°E 07 links.

Found no evidence of subsequent restoration of this corner.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Luce County Remonumentation Program. Found a bent 11/2" i.d. iron pipe next to a broken off wood post. The found pipe is 2657.4 feet from the section corner at I-3 to the south (GLO distance is 2640 feet), 2555.4 feet from an original section corner on the township line at I-1 to the north (GLO distance is 2564.8 feet), and is 11.5 feet west of a straight line between said section corners. Accepted the found pipe as best evidence of the corner location. Set a ½" rebar and stamped aluminum Luce County Remonumentation cap at the base of the found pipe.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set a ½" x 18" rebar with a stamped aluminum Luce County Remonumentation cap at the corner location, at the base of a found pipe, next to a broken off wood post. Witnesses:
