(B-3) 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 6 and 7, T. 45 N., R. 11 W. This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Luce County Remonumentation Program.

Could find no evidence of the original corner or subsequent restoration.

Reestablished corner position by single proportionate measurement between the section corners 1/2 mile West, 2574.00' (GLO), 2578.47' (meas) and 1/2 mile East, 2640.00 (GLO), 2644.58' (meas).

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(B-3) 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 6 and 7, T. 45 N., R. 11 W.

Corner is a 1/2" x 48" re-bar with a stamped aluminum Luce County Remonumentation cap. Corner is 300' North of an

old East-West logging road and 1.0' South of a steel fence post.


