MSHD plans for old M-98 (1/2 mile East) show an angle and distance from the survey centerline at 1/4 corner 1957 8|17 to the section corner. The plans do not mention what was located for the section corner.

(C-5) Section Corner Common to Sections 7, 8, 17 and 18, T. 45 N., R. 11 W. This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Luce County Remonumentation Program.

3. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

DWEI'A Found no evidence of the original corner or subsequent restoration. Could find no evidence of a corner at the angle and distance as shown on the highway plans from the 1/4 corner to the East. The MSHD distance is 71.1' short of record and 64.7' short of a prorated GLO distance.

Reestablished the corner by proportionate measurement between the 1/4 corners 1/2 mile East and West and at a record GLO distance from the 1/4 corner 1/2 mile North. The meander corner to the South is lost.

3. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner.

(C-5) Section Corner Common to Sections 7, 8, 17 and 18, T. 45 N., R. 11 W.

Corner is a 1/2" x 24" re-bar with a stamped aluminum Luce County Remonumentation cap.
