B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(C-6) 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 17 and 18, T. 45 N., R. 11 W. This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Luce County Remonumentation Program.

Found no evidence of the original corner. Reestablished the corner position by extending section line 7|8 South the record GLO distance (2640'). This position also agrees with a mean bearing of the section lines to the East and West.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(C-6) 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 17 and 18, T. 45 N., R. 11 W.

Corner is a 1/2" x 48" re-bar with a stamped aluminum Luce County Remonumentation cap. The corner falls approximately 100' Northeast of the shore - shoreline runs NW-SE, and 132.00' North of a meander corner at the shore.
