B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: (G-5) This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Luce County Remonumentation program.

Found 1-3/4" O.D. pipe 12" A.G. 12' West of centerline North-South gravel road. Also, found 2 witness pipes, (probably set by J. Kinsey Co. Surveyor) to Northwest and Southeast. The pipe to the Northwest appears to have been run over by a skidder. Sawed it off and straightened. The pipe to the Southeast also was leaning - and fell at the edge of a cleared area. It appears to have been moved - may even be a newer pipe. Straightened it to use as a witness. Also, found record Fearing tree to Southeast. Straightened it to use as a witness. Also, found record Bearing tree to Southwest. Accepted corner position as found and added 3 new witnesses.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(G-5) Corner is a 1-3/4" pipe, 12" above ground and 12' West of the centerline of a North-South road. Corner also falls 20' +/- North of a 3-way intersection.
