A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(G-6) 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 15 and 16, T. 45 N., R. 11 W.

1849 William Ives set post for corner in original survey.

Could find no subsequent survey history on this corner in available public records.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(G-6) 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 15 and 16, T. 45 N., R. 11 W. This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Luce County Remonumentation Program.

Found remains of possible original BT's. Found large maple down and partially rotted with evidence of scaring consistent with blazing. Also found mound at the location of the beech. The position for the corner works well with GLO. Distance to section corner South 2640' (GLO), 2644.49' (meas). Distance to the meander corner on the North side of a small lake to the North, 1749' (GLO), 1734.91' (meas). The 1/4 corner falls 6.2' West of a line between the section corner and meander corner.

Reestablished 1/4 corner at record bearing and distance from the remains of the 2 trees.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(G-6) 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 15 and 16, T. 45 N., R. 11 W.

Corner is a 1/2" x 48" re-bar with a stamped aluminum Luce County Remonumentation cap. The corner falls in a wooded area, 37' West of an old North-South fence line.
