A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(K-3) Section Comer Common to Sections 1, 2, 11 and 12, T. 45 N., R. 11 W.

1849 William lives set post for corner in the original survey with 2 sugar maples for witnesses.

Highway Department plans by J.P. Smallwood show a 3/4" re-bar for the section corner with 3 witnesses and a 1967 distance to the 1/4 corner to the South as 2656.54'

Billy Buckler, P.S. 8887, recorded corner in page 187 of Luce County Corner Records. Buckler recovered the corner and witnesses as shown on the 1967 highway department drawings.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(K-3) Section Corner Common to Sections 1, 2, 11 and 12, T. 45 N., R. 11 W. This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Luce County Remonumentation Program.

Found no evidence of the original corner. Found the 3/4" iron recorded by Buckler in 1974, the distance to the 1/4" corner to the South measures 1.0' short of the distance shown on 1967 Highway Department plans. Accepted the corner position as recovered.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(K-3) Section Corner Common to Sections 1, 2, 11 and 12, T. 45 N., R. 11 W.

Corner is a 3/4" iron projecting 5" above ground. The corner falls in a wooded area 150' North of a old RR grade and 50' West of a woods road.
