

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(M-10) 1/4 Corner Common to Section 25, T. 45 N., R. 11 W. and Section 30, T. 45 N., R. 10 W. This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Luce County Remonumentation Program.

Found a 1" pipe with a 4" aluminum DNR cap stamped 1992 at the position recorded by Buckler in 1967. The position as monumented falls 3.23' West and 0.70' South of a single proportionate position between the section corner 1/2 mile North and the township corner 1 1/2 miles South. Could find no trace of the original corner or other contrary evidence and accepted the corner as found.
