

1967 Billy Buckler, P.S. 8887, re-established the corner by single proportionate measurement between section corners one mile North and one mile South. Buckler set a 1" pipe with a 4" aluminum cap and recorded the corner in 1970 in page 722, Luce County Corner Records.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(M-11) Section Corner Common to Sections 25 & 36, T. 45 N., R. 11 W. and Sections 30 & 31, T. 45 N., R. 10 W. This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Luce County Remonumentation Program.

Recovered corner as monumented by Buckler in 1967. The monument falls 1.59' West and 2.63' South of a point midway and on line between the section corners one mile North and one mile South. Could find no evidence of the original corner or any other contrary evidence and accepted the corner as recovered.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(M-11) Section Corner Common to Sections 25 & 36, T. 45 N., R. 11 W. and Sections 30 & 31, T. 45 N., R. 10 W.

Corner is a 1" pipe with a 4" Dept. of Conservation aluminum cap, 1' above ground. The corner falls on a North-South ridge in the hardwoods +/- 100' South of old East-West grade.
