1960 Billy Buckler, P.S. 8887, found an old cedar post at the intersection of old township roads South and East. Buckler re-monumented the corner with a 1" pipe with a 4" Dept. of Conservation brass cap and recorded the corner in 1961 in page 428 of the Luce County Corner Records.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(M-13) Township Corner Common to Townships T45N-R11W, T45N-R10W, T44N-R11W and T44N-R10W This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Luce County Remonumentation Program.

Manual September 1912 Recovered Buckler's corner as monumented in 1960. Could find no evidence of the original corner or any other contrary evidence. Accepted Buckler's monument for the township corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
