B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Corner reestablished as part of the Luce County Remonumentation Program.

Found remains of a North-South fence line on South side of road. Did not hold fence line. Reestablished corner position midway and on line between the Northeast and Northwest corners of Section 23. Corner position falls 27' West of extension of fence line to South. Falls 33' North of remains of South right-of-way fence.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner is a 1/2" x 24" iron with a 3 1/4" diameter stamped aluminum cap, 6" below gravel road surface. Falls 4' North of centerline of County Road 436 (East-West, gravel). Falls 27' West of extension of fence line to South. Falls 33' North of remains of South right-of-way fence. Open field to North.
