Karr, in a field survey on December 19, 1997, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the comer points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

Could find no subsequent survey history on this comer in available public records.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(L-3) 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 1 and 12, T. 45 N., R. 12 W.

This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Luce County Remonumentation Program.

Found no evidence of the original corner or subsequent restoration. Found a 1/2" iron on the North edge of a gravel road to the West at the approximate location of the corner. Could find no indication of the iron being set or used as the 1/4 corner. Reestablished the 1/4 corner by single proportionate measurement between the section corners to the East and West.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(L-3) 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 1 and 12, T. 45 N., R. 12 W.

Corner is a 1/2" x 48" re-bar with a stamped aluminum Luce County Remonumentation cap. The corner falls 6' South of the centerline of a gravel road to the West and on the extension of the East edge of the pavement of a county road to the South. The corner is set 0.4' below grade.
