

5. Private Claims

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Luce County Remonumentation Program.

Found a 1" iron pipe with a brass DNR cap and the two cedar bearing trees as called for in the 1957 DNR records, the cedar northeast is in very poor condition. Accepted corner as found and established additional bearing trees.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Found a 1" iron pipe with a brass DNR cap at the corner location, next to a squared, scribed wood post. Witnesses:

12" Cedar, N79°E 21.58'
14" Cedar, S52°E 22.84'
10" Cedar, S16°E 10.22'
9" Tamarack, N56°W 26.25'
5" Cedar, N25°E 14.74'

Note: Distances are to a nail/tag #33142 in the side of the tree. Trees are blazed and painted.

Bearings are compass bearings corrected for declination.
