A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

J-5 1/4 Corner common to Sections 11 & 14, Town 46 North, Range 10 West

1853 - Original corner was established by George H. Cannon, D.S. Witnesses: Cedar 18, S20°E 17 links Cedar 12, N40°W 19 links

1963 - Michigan Department of Conservation, Forestry Division, Land Corner Record, Billy D. Buckler, RLS 8887 Recorded in Luce County Corner Records, page 457A. Corner replaced from two original cedar bearing trees, a stump bearing S20°E 17 links and a down cedar bearing N40°W 19 links. Set 1" pipe with aluminum cap. Witnesses: 7" White Birch, S10°W 24 links - 7" Aspen, S70°E 21 links.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Luce County Remonumentation Program. Found a 1" iron pipe with an aluminum DNR cap and both bearing trees as called for in 1963 DNR records. Accepted corner as found and established additional bearing trees.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Found a 1" iron pipe with an aluminum DNR cap the corner location. Witnesses:

10" White Birch, S18°W 15.83' 10" Aspen, S65°E 14.39' 6" Balsam Fir, N30°E 46.52' 8" White Birch, N46°W 32.61'

Note: Distances are to a nail/tag #33142 in the side of tree. Trees are blazed and painted.

Bearings are compass bearings corrected for declination.
