5. Private Claims

I, Keith R. - A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Found no evidence of subsequent restoration of this corner.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:


This corner is being reestablished as part of the Luce County Remonumentation Program. Found no evidence of this corner or its accessories. Reestablished corner by single proportionate measurement midway on line between section corners east and west. The distance between said section corners is within 4 feet of the original GLO distance. (Note: The position used for the section corner K-3 is not the previously recorded position as shown in LCRC's in liber 2, page 641, liber 2, page 680, and liber 2, page 683).

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Placed a ½" x 18" rebar with a stamped aluminum Luce County Remonumentation cap at the corner location. Witnesses:

9" Cedar, S56°E 42.40' 12" Tamarack, N83°E 24.91' 8" Cedar, N18°E 37.35' 10" Tamarack, S38°W 12.90'

Note: Distances are to a nail/tag #33142 in the side of the tree. Trees are blazed and painted. Bearings are compass bearings corrected for declination.
