Stresbesti , in a field survey on \$ Setaber \$1, 1997 , 19 do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as

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A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

[MI3] Quarter corner common to Section 34, 7478-216W and Section 3, 7468-210W. Corner previously recorded by Billy D. Buckler as recovered and remonstrated in 1956, according to original evidence. Suckler's new bearing trees are: 10° Cedar BOIL 10 Links, marked "1/48 NBT": 11" Codar \$23W 15.5 Links, marked "1/48 NBT".

- [5] Borth 1/16 corner, Section 18. Corner not established in original survey. Found no other record.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(RI3) Found no evidence of Buckler's monument, recorded as a 1° pipe with a 6° brass cap. Benoaumented the corner in accord with Buckler's bearing trees, both recovered as recorded. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1"x32" painted iron pipe capped with a cast aluminum Michigan Dept. of Batural Resources tablet, appropriately stamped. Remarked the top blaze on Buckler's Codar Boll, and top and bottom blazes on his Cedar \$230. Harked two new bearing trees, as described below.

(5) Established corner equidistant and on a straight line between the North 1/4 corner of Section 18, recorded by Billy D. Suckler in 1973, and the Center of Section 18, recorded by Billy D. Buckler in 1981. Found the distance between these two previously recorded corners to be 2637.18 feet.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(113) Set a 1"x32" pipe with MDIR cap. Blazed, scribed, and set measuring mails in the following new bearing trees: 6" Codar \$532, 10.05", arkd "1/45 BOY" 10" Codar #28E 8.0', arkd "1/48 #87" Placed measuring mails in Duckler's BT's as follows: 12" Cedar 382E 7.22'

13° Cedar \$23W 10.35'



(5) Placed a 1"232" painted iron pipe capped with a cast aluminum HDBE tablet. Blazed, scribed, and set measuring mails in the following bearing trees: 8" Maple B33W, 28.2'(slope), "1/16 BT" 8" Maple 837E, 36.8', "1/16 BT" 10" W. Pine 587E, 50.32', "1/16 BT" 5" W. Pine S53E, 61.3', "1/16 87"
