Szyszkoski . in a Held survey on _______. do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(C3) Corner common to Sections 5-6-7-8. Corner remonumented in 1957 by Billy D. Buckler, RtS, from original bearing trees, both in fair condition. Buckler placed a 1" iron pipe with 4" brass cap and the following witnesses: 7" W. Pine M82E 39 links, 6" Balsam S22E 28.5 links. Found no subsequent record.

(7-Sec. 6) North 1/16 corner between Sections 5-6. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(C3) Found and accepted Buckler's monument, in good condition, and at record bearing and distance from the 1957 W. Pine witness. The 6° Balsam was not recovered. Left the monument in place, remarked the top blaze of the M. Pine, and marked three new accessories as described below.

(7-Sec. 6) found no evidence of prior monumentation at the corner position. Established the corner on a straight line between 1/4 corner 1314.67' south and Section Corner 1523.71' north, the position being 20 chains, proportionate measure, north of the 1/4 corner. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1"I.D.x32" iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MDMR tablet, appropriately stamped.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(7) Set 1" pipe with 4" MDNR cap. (C3) Found 1" pipe with 4" brass HI (Blazed and scribed the following bearing Dept. of Conservation cap. Blazed and scribed the following: trees: "SS NBT" 4" 8alsam S25W 11.3' "M1/16 BT" 14" W. Pine N82E 26.2" 8" Maple M62E 21.4" "S5 NBT" 6" W. Birch \$22E 3.95' "N1/16 BT" 6" W.
