A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

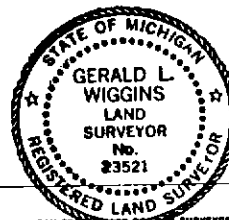
Section Corner common to 4-5-8-9. Set by Billy D. Buckler R.L.S. on Aug. 2, 1956.
