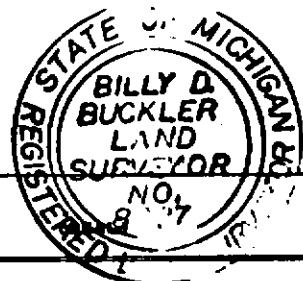
J-7 A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

J-7 B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:
 Re-placed corner from original witness; the Cedar, N57°W, 33 lks., in poor condition. Found wood post in place.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
 Placed 1" pipe with 4" Aluminium cap at corner.
J-7 New bearings: 10" Cedar, S72°W, 30.15' and 6" Cedar, S22°E, 22.05' and 12" Cedar, N44°E, 15.80'.
