I. <u>Staphan J. Szyszkaski</u>, in a field survey on <u>May 96, 1993</u>, 19 , do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(K6) Quarter corner common to Sections 13-14. Corner previously recorded by Billy D. Buckler RLS, in 1957 as monumented by a 1° pipe with 4° brass cap. 1957 MBTs: 10° M. Pine M34E 11 links, 13° M. Pine S75E 45 links. Found no subsequent record.

(8) West 1/16 corner, Section 13. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record.

(11) Southwest 1/16 corner of Section 13. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(K6) found and accepted Buckler's monument as described, at record bearing and distance from the M. Pine M8T M34E, which is in good condition. The second bearing tree has blown over. Marked 3 new bearing trees as described below.

(8) Established the corner midway and on a straight line between 1/4 corner 1326.05' west and Center of Section 1326.05' east, both corners of record. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1"x32" iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MDMR tablet, appropriately stamped. From the corner established, an old squared post, apparently an approximate corner, was found 0.4" north and 4.8" east.

(ii) Found no evidence of prior monumentation at the corner position. Established the corner at the intersection of straight lines connecting opposite I/16 corners. The I/16 corners N and N being monumented, and those E and S being unmonumented computed positions midway between adjacent I/4 corners. At the position for the corner I placed a 1"x32" iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MONR tablet, appropriately stamped.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(E4) Found 1° pipe with 4° brass cap.

(8) Set 1° pipe with 4° MDMR cap.
