Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration.
[13] Corner common to Sections 2-3-10-11. Corner remonumented in 1957 at the original position as determined by recovered original bearing trees by Billy D. Buckler, ALS. Buckler placed a 1" a4 ft. iron pipe buried 6" deep at the corner and marked the following: B Jacksine M63# 103 links, 8" Jackpine S74W 174 links. Found no subsequent record.

(G5) Corner common to Sections 9-10-15-18. Corner remonumented in 1958 by Billy D. Buckler, RLS. Replaced corner in intersection of firelanes. Found evidence of old post in soil, found Yellow Pine B.T. to KW, down, could not determine exact position of B.T. Found stump hale \$61M 26 links. Corner manument: 2' iron pipe buried in intersection of M-S-E-W firelanes. Witnesses to corner: 15' Red Pine N31E 73 links, 12" White Pine S63E 102 links".

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

(13) Recovered the 1957 monument, as described, in good condition, at record bearing and distance from the 1957 Jack Pine witnesses, both standing. The Jack Pine N63M is now dead. That ST4W is green. Re-marked the top blaze of this tree, placed a measuring nail with tag in it, and marked three new bearing trees as described below. Corner recovered and rewitnessed by T.Stark and D.Lampela, Newberry District Office.

(G5) Recovered a 1° iron pipe capped with a 4° brass Michigan Dept. of Conservation tablet, in good condition, and at record bearing and distance from the 1958 mitnesses, both in good condition. Accepted the monument as marking the position determined in 1958 by Buckler. Left the monument in place, made new BH markings on the 1958 witness trees, and made two new witnesses as described below.
