A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

{BS} Quarter corner common to Sections 20-29. Corner previously recorded by Silly D. Suckler as recovered and monumented in 1958 at a 2" iron pipe set by Marcus Schaaf, Reg. Surveyor. Buckler's witnesses are: 12" White Pine (1/48 MBT) 849W 18.5 Links, and 13" White Pine {1/48 MBT} M39W 30.5 Links.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(D3) Found Suckler's monument, a 1° pipe with a 4° brass cap, removed from the ground, and Schanf's pipe bent over. Remonumented the corner, as described below, at the position of Schaaf's pipe and Buckler's bearing trees, which were found as recorded. The corner lies in the center of an E-W road, buried beneath the road surface.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner;

(D3) Set a 1"x32" painted iron pipe capped with a yellow plastic cap stamped "Mich. DER LE 13986". Blazed, scribed, and set measuring mails in the following new bearing trees: 14" R.
