From monument located GLO BT locations, search inconclustve Also located references from 1975 report. BT in NE position is dead and down and BT in NW position is dead but standing. From the monument position ran corrected compass line on GLO bearing North to 40.0 chains. Found 1 1/4" G.I.P. with 3 1/4" aluminum cap, State of Michigan, 7-9-75, R.L.S. no. 8887, stamped on cap. Accepted granite monument as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner. Area around corner position is an open Jack Pine plantation that in time past has been badly burned over. C.
