A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(E8) Quarter corner common to Sections 20-21. Corner remonumented in 1952 by Dean C. DetaMater from one original B1, in good condition. The 1952 record states: Sat 1° pipe with 4° Bress cap, 9° W. Pine M40M 44 links, 8° Red Pine 835W 80 links.

{14-Sec.21} South 1/16 corner between Sections 21-22. Corner not established in the original survey, Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner;

(E8) Found and accepted DeLaMater's monument as described, at record bearing and distance from the 1952 MBTs, both in good condition. Placed measuring nails in these MBTs, marked new upper blazes, and also marked two new bearing trees as described below. Corner lies approximately 42' north of a trail road.

(14-Sec.21) Found no evidence of prior monumentation at the corner position. Established the corner midway and on a straight line between Quarter corner 1320.99' North and Section corner 1320.99' South. Monumented the corner position with a 1° I.D.x36' painted iron pipe capped with a 4° dia, cast aluminum MONR tablet, appropriately stamped.
