- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- (L11) Found the 1970 monument, in good condition and at record bearing and distance from the 1970 witness trees, both in good condition. I found the monument to be west of the intended proportionate position by 17'. I note that Mr. Buckler had previously subdivided this section and monumented many of the interior corners. Those corners have been in place and accepted for over 35 years. I did not desire to disturb the monumentation of this section by adjusting the monument to the exact proportionate position intended in 1970 and so accepted the monument as marking the position for the 1/4 corner.
- (8-Sec. 25) Found the 1970 monument in good condition, at the record position, and at record bearing and distance from the two 1970 witnesses. The J.Pine NW is standing dead. The J.Pine NE is in good condition. Accepted the monument as a careful and faithful establishment of the position of the corner.
