Found 1/2" smooth iron rod in West side 16" multi-trunk Maple in root as set and witnessed by Ronnie Lester in June, 1973. This iron is 41 feet: south of the centerline of Bowdish Road and 329 feet east of the centerline of Jaycox Road. Lester states that he set this section corner on line and at 1/2 distance between B-13 (S1/4 cor. Sec.31) and D-13 (S1/4 cor. Sec. 32), Page 12 and 13. We found by field measures that this iron rod falls 50' east of 1/2 distance and 37' south of line. (B-13 to D-13). These measures, that we made, were also confirmed by Charles Wilson in a survey breaking down Section 6, Lyndon Twp., T1S, R3E, Page 14-14E. B-13 to D-13, Hughes 1995, 5232.15', Lester 1973, 5331.32', Wilson 1991, 5231.92'.

I propose to set C-13 at 1/2 distance between B-13 and D-13 on the extension of the B-13, B-1 line, 277.87 East of B-1.
